The note [DP] in a rule in this Notice of Race means that the penalty for violation of the rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than cancellation.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing – Windsurfing Fleet Racing Edition (WCR Appendix B)*.
- 1.2 The [Class Rules of Division II Association](#) shall apply.
- 1.3 The race is counting for the Division 2 Global Trophy 2023 with coefficient 1 and for the Division 2 Annual Ranking List with coefficient 1,5 for competitors who are at least base members of ID2CA and race with board and sails tagged with stickers.
- 1.4 **COVID-19 Protocols**
Protocols relating to COVID-19 may be published at any time and will state if they have a status of a rule.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes RRS 63.7
- 1.6 To the rule 61.1 is added: A boat intending to protest must inform the Race Committee of the boat against which the protest is to be made, immediately after the finish

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative at the event. Class Representative at the event will be the Vice President of ID2CA Stratos Efthyvoulidis.

3. CLASSES & DIVISIONS

- 3.1 **Gender Divisions** – Men and Women.
- 3.2 **Age Division: Youth**- sailors under 25 years old
- 3.2 **Sail Type divisions: A and C.**
- 3.3 A minimum of 3 competitors is required to constitute a division.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 **Eligible competitors** may enter online here: <https://www.nasyop.gr/diaporos-regatta-2023-registration-form/>
- 4.2 For Greek competitors, National Prescription new rule 76.4 shall apply (valid EIO card and valid health card). These cards must be submitted to the Registration Office at registration.
- 4.3 The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - Evidence of valid third-party insurance
 - Proof of age
parental permission form- *for those under the age of 18*
- 4.4 **Support personnel** may register onsite, and the following shall be presented upon registration:
 - Boat Driving License [DP]
 - Evidence of valid third-party insurance

5. FEES

- 5.1 Entry fee is: 50 Euros.
- 5.2 Fees paid upon registration must be in cash.

6. ADVERTISING

- 1. Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority according to the WS rule 20. [DP]

7. FORMAT OF RACING

- 1. The event will be a racing “open entry” event.
- 2. A and C division boards will have separate results.
- 3. Men and women may race together, depending on entry numbers.
- 4. A and C division may start together, depending on entry numbers.
- 5. There shall be a maximum 4 races per day in a maximum 9 race series.
- 6. It will be one discard if 6 races are completed and two discards if 8 races are completed.
- 7. One race is required to validate the Cup for each division.

8. SCHEDULE

- 8.1 Dates and times of registration, meetings, and racing

- 8.2 No more than four (4) races may be sailed each day.
- 8.3 On the last day of racing, no warning signal, will be made after 16:00

9. EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 9.1 Equipment shall be tagged to be eligible to race – check [Class Rules](#).
- 9.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 9.3 Upon completion of registration and until the end of the event, always when ashore except when launching and retrieving, all equipment shall be kept in

their assigned places at event site. Removal of any equipment from the event site requires prior written approval from the race committee. Access to equipment in the storage area during certain hours, including hours of darkness may be restricted.

10. VENUE

Addendum A shows the location of the club, regatta harbor and the racing areas.

11. COURSES

11.1 Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 RRS Appenix P will apply.

12.2 In case of breach of a rule of part 2 (when boats meet) the penalty of two turns will apply.

13. SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A.

14. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

1. Team and support vessel drivers shall register their vessels at the Race Office before the start of the event. The registrations shall include sail numbers of boats they are supporting [DP].

15. SAFETY

Personal buoyancy is prescribed as mandatory for every competitor and support boat crew-member, who shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's.

16. PRIZES

16.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 competitors of a properly constituted division.

16.2 Separate prizes will be awarded to the first 3 Greek competitors as winners of the Hellenic National Cup.

17. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organizing authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for nonattendance at the prize giving ceremony.**

18. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a board's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, board handling errors, poor seamanship by other boards, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent,**

catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

19. INSURANCE

Each participating board shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

20. MEDIA RIGHTS

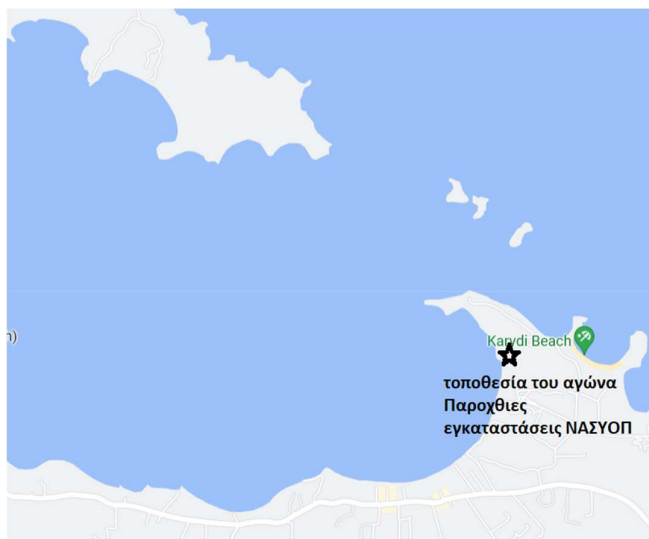
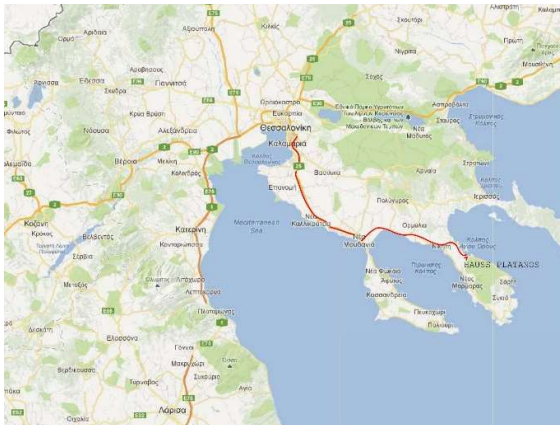
